

From the Founder



Quality International School as seen today has come a long way. QIS is the outcome of the experiences of the founder which she gathered in education locally and globally. She attended primary in PS Azire, Secondary school in Saker Baptist College and High School in the Cameroon College of Arts, Science and Technology Bambili. After high school, she won the US embassy ASPAU scholarship to study at the University of Ibadan Nigeria and after 3 years, graduated with a B.Sc in Biochemistry in 1972. She returned to Cameroon where different job opportunities were available. She decided to teach science in secondary school, PSS Kumba and various high schools including CAST Kumba, CCAST Bambili and the Government Bilingual High school Essos, Yaounde. While teaching in GBHS Essos, she led a number of students of the Green Club to establish flower and vegetable gardens and a recreational park on the school campus. Africa 2000

[United Nations Environmental Program] accompanied the work in that project.

After 12 years of impacting students and colleagues within the school and classrooms, she was appointed Provincial and later National pedagogy inspector for Biology, in the Ministry of National Education in September 1987, where she served until retirement from the Cameroon civil service in 2008. Apart from being pedagogic inspector, Mrs. Margaret Besong had other duties at the GCE Board as examiner, chief examiner and member of the EEC progressively from 1977 to 2008. She was also Country coordinator of the GLOBE Program (Global Learning and Observations to Benefit the Environment) in Cameroon from November 1998 to 2008.

In carrying out her duties in the education sector in Cameroon, she was dissatisfied with three major factors that could be improved upon. First, she was not satisfied with the school environment which was often very dirty and not conducive for learning. God, the Master planner and Educator was often not in the school system. Second, she found the system of education not adapted to meet the needs of the African child; rote learning instead of developing critical thinking skills for better educational outcomes was practiced. Third, the fact that she realized that the same challenges she had for effective transfer of knowledge was not unique to her alone, but was also in the mind of many others who lacked expression. She therefore chose to create the opportunity.

In September 2002, Quality International School was born in response to the needs identified. She shared the vision with some friends and family who supported her in many ways and in different capacities.

She thanks God for each of them and the sacrifices they made. As the founder looks back, her dear friend and husband Mr. Joseph Besong, for many years was her greatest mentor. He believed in her and spurred her to attempt great things for God and for man, using all the gifts and talents she had. She acknowledges with gratitude, the hand of God from the very conception of QIS.

The school began with 27 students and 4 teaching staff handling the nursery, class one and class two in a rented home, now QIS Annex. Today, we are looking at over a thousand students managed by 85 staff from pre-nursery to high school. While the number of students was growing, the difficult terrain acquired for the school posed a huge challenge. This was soon confirmed as the retention wall that was being built to carry the school structures collapsed before it was even completed. This was a very discouraging phase in the project but with faithful friends like Mr Nju Philemon, she got in contact with Mr Tanko George who with the expertise of other engineers set to work. The school was gradually built from 2006 to today. Quality International School now has 3 blocks - The Alpha block has the Head teacher's office and 3 other offices, 20 classrooms, a conference room, a computer lab, photocopy room and a sick bay. The Beta block has the Principal's office, a staff room and 6 classrooms. The Gamma Block has 5 classrooms, the computer lab and science lab with a prep room, 2 offices and a prayer room. Two large assembly halls are located on the ground floor of the Beta and Gamma blocks.

Water is life. In QIS, there is a regular supply of very clean water from the school's borehole, in a city where portable water is a challenge. It is worth noting that at each floor, there are clean toilets. The founder is totally grateful to all the technical and teaching staff who are sacrificing in one way or the other to the progress of the institution. She would like to acknowledge the following: Miss Emelda Ngando the first head teacher of QIS, Mr Tambi Daniel the second. From 2007 to present, the founder has not only had a head teacher, but a daughter, a sister, a friend, a servant, a parent, a counsellor, and administrator, in the person of Mrs Margaret Asang Perem who four years ago, also became the Assistant Manager. At the secondary level, she acknowledges our first principal Mr Orock Tabe Denis, Mr Kiven Valery, Miss Aneibu Rockzine, Mr Foncham Nelvien for being there even when things were tough. Mr. Mayaga Lazare Francois is a faithful security/logistics officer of the school who is there 24/7.

In the beginning of QIS, God has been El - Shaddai, Every day of thedays God has been Adonai and forever God remains Elyon.

Because the Lord lives, QIS looks forward to a brighter tomorrow in which the kingdom of our God and of His Christ will be established fully in this institution. Discipline will become a way of life for all staff and students. Integrity, honesty and high morals will become a lifestyle. Hard work and proper time management will be a hallmark for all to achieve set goals thus changing the lives of students and staff for the better and why not Cameroon and the world?

As we celebrate 20 years, we are positioned to take off to greater heights. To God be the glory!


It was a great privilege serving in this institution from its foundation (2002-2005) and seeing how much God and the society is gaining from the output of this institution, I can only say Glory to God!



THE COMPUTER LABORATORY AT QIS

A computer laboratory is a room or space equipped with computers (networked or not) devoted to pedagogical use in a school including school libraries. A computer laboratory must be safe from any disruptive, -pedagogical content; pupils and teachers may need authorized access credentials. The computer laboratory at QIS is no different. From its maiden days of thirty five desktop computers (20 in the primary and 15 in the secondary) the computer laboratory served as a whole new world of learning for the students.

When students engaged technology in their day-to-day academic routines, they got a lot of assistance from it. With the technology of computers and the internet, the experience of studying and doing assignments has never been the same.

Students of the modern-day world cannot imagine studies without the internet and computers, where the work and getting help become seamless and efficient. With the use of computers, a student's life has been made very convenient. By just using this device, students can write and research their school works online and communicate with their classmates and teachers through email or other platforms for shared discussions and knowledge.

Indeed, a computer is a big help in making student life easier. Including computers as one of the learning tools in school is essential. With the use of computers, students are more likely to enjoy studying, resulting in better performance. They feel more involved and focused when computers are in use. More so, using a computer in education lets each student collaborate and, at the same time, teach them to become independent. Through the use of technology and the internet combined, students come across a lot of different opportunities. This way, they can find detailed information about them, see what fits best for their aspirations and success, and decide accordingly. They can also interact with fellow professionals through messengers and learn from their experiences.



THE COMPUTER LABORATORY AT QIS

The QIS students at Ministry of Secondary education to present one of their STEM projects At QIS the students were engaged in several ICT and STEM based projects to give them a head start on career orientation towards computer science and technology. For the past six years QIS students have participated in the Technovation challenge competition organized by Iridescent and American company that promotes women and girls interested in science and technology. Technovation challenge requires girls of ages 8-18 to create mobile applications that can solve problems in their communities. Students at QIS have presented mobile apps such as Hemo – a mobile app that links blood donors to recipients, QIS e-Learning - an app that students can review past examination questions, VVoice- a voting app, justListen – an audiobook app and the list goes on.

QIS students also worked on other ICT and STEM projects such as STEM prize organized by Denis and Lenora Foretia foundation and Tech-Girls an international summer exchange program designed to empower and inspire young women from around the world to pursue careers in science and technology.

This year 2022, came with the increase in the number of computers to fifty five (in the secondary) and this led to the first G.C.E practical in Information and Communication Technology to be organized in the computer laboratory of QIS. Students from four schools were accommodated during the examination (NESCAS, College Bilingue La Gloire, Harvard College and QIS).

Thank you for what you have helped me with Q.I.S, and I hope to see you succeed in the future.


